**Camp Schedule:** Space is limited to the first 18 campers. (Riders must be at least 6 years of age.)

- Camp 1: June 18-22
- Camp 2: June 25-29
- Camp 3: July 2-6

**Time:** 9am-3pm

**Days:** Monday-Friday.

**Cost:** \$500 per Camp per rider. \$100 nonrefundable deposit due with camp application

**Multiple Camp Savings:** \$450 per Camp if Rider does more than one camp.

**Before & After Camp Supervision:** Available 7-9 am and 3:30 – 6 pm @ \$15/hour.

**Food:** CCF will provide a snack each day and a lunch on Friday. Please pack a lunch and water bottles daily with camper's name on them.

**Attire:** Short sleeve shirt (no tank tops). Long pants (breeches/jodphers preferred) Paddock boots. If you need to purchase any of these items, please visit "Saddles to Boots" in Sebastopol.

**Lessons outside of camp during camp weeks:** *There will be no lessons available on school horses M-F of camp weeks. There will be regular lessons Saturday and Sunday of each week.*
